



B&D Timber Coat is an acrylic based coating, applied to steel sectional doors. The process involves applying up to 12 coats of paint to the door. Curing time can take up to 6-8 weeks from installation (depending on climate conditions).

If the door is wrapped in its transport plastic, and gets wet, before it is fully cured, the paint can take on a mottled look.

DO NOT PANIC.

This is quite normal for an uncured door. Your dealer will still install your door, as this is the best way for the curing process to continue. In most situations, the door will dry out over a few days, but it can take up to several weeks, depending on the humidity.

While your door is drying and curing;

X DO NOT wash or rub the door surface.

X DO NOT touch or pop any blisters that may have formed in the paint surface.

Your door will dry, if left to cure on its own.

After 12 weeks, you can wash your door, with a soft cloth and soapy water.
