Title: Code Handset to Receiver GTX U3



The receiver features 4 separate channels which allows four separate handsets (transmitters) to operate


1. Remove Cover

Open Control box by removing screw and carefully remove by tilting cover from bottom




2. Locate receiver board

- Receiver board is located in the upper left region of the main circuit board
- The receiver is identified by the brown antenna wire attached



3. Press Learn Button

- Red LED #1 will illuminate representing channel 1.
- To select an alternate channel press Learn button until desired LED is illuminated (ie: press twice for channel 2; press four times for channel 4).



- 4. Press the large button on the handset
 - All four LED's on receiver will flash to confirm that the handset has been successfully programmed.
 - Carefully replace cover and affix with screw.
 - Always use the large button to program remote, even if the door is configured to operate using one of the smaller buttons



Note: Additional remotes must be programmed to separate channels
